
## Program Details

- Purpose: To provide cost of books and material for Mahamaya Girls' College alumnae pursuing undergraduate or graduate studies in the US and Canada
- Application process: Each candidate is required to complete the MGCAANA Undergraduate and Graduate Scholarship Application that is available on paper and online
- Application deadline: Usually December
- Selection process:
  - All applications are carefully reviewed by the Scholarship Selection Committee and names and details of the finalists are presented to the MGCAANA BOD and Executive Committee for approval
  - Scholarships are awarded to students demonstrating outstanding academic achievements, leadership ability, participation in extracurricular activities, and a significant level of financial need
