

Mahamaya Girls' College Alumnae Association of North America 2023-2024 Undergraduate & Graduate Scholarship Application

Instructions & Requirements

- 1. Please read all instructions carefully before completing this application.
- 2. This scholarship is intended to provide the cost of books and materials for one semester, for MGCAANA members pursuing undergraduate or graduate studies in the United States and Canada.
- 3. One (1) scholarship of **\$300** will be awarded this year.
- 4. A single student is eligible to receive only one award; and the scholarship is not renewable.
- 5. It is not required for the applicant to be a MGCAANA member to receive the scholarship. The scholarship will be awarded together with a **complimentary one-year MGCAANA student membership**.
- 6. Relatives of the Board of Directors and Officers of MGCAANA are eligible to apply if they qualify. In such an instance, the particular Board Member or Officer will be asked to refrain from participating in the scholarship selection process.
- 7. Prospective scholarship applicants will be notified through the MGCAANA website, e-mail, and newsletter.
- 8. The scholarship will be awarded to a student demonstrating outstanding academic achievements, leadership abilities, participation in extracurricular activities while facing significant financial need.
- Students should have at least 12 semester credits and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 will be considered only in special circumstances (required to explain in Part 4 Personal Statement)
- 10. All Scholarship applicants are required to send the following supporting documentation.
 - a) Completed application form
 - b) Unofficial copies of ALL college transcripts
 - c) Incoming high school students are required to include copies of their high school transcript(s) -
 - G.C.E Ordinary Level and Advanced Level Examination Certificates (if applicable).
 - d) Employment Verification documents (if applicable)– Pay stubs of 3 months or job Appointment letter.
 - e) A personal statement (please refer to page 3 of this application for further instructions).
- 11. Students must read and complete the Financial Need section of this scholarship application.

12. APPLICATION PERIOD AND DEADLINE: October 15, 2023 – February 29, 2024

- 13. The scholarship winner will be notified by March 31, 2024 via email.
