- To promote excellence in academic and non-academic activities of current students of Mahamaya Girls' College, Kandy, Sri Lanka





### MGCAANA Undergraduate and Graduate Scholarship Program

- This scholarship is intended to provide the cost of books and material for a single semester for MGCAANA members pursuing undergraduate and graduate studies in the United States and Canada
- The scholarship is awarded to a student demonstrating outstanding academic achievements, leadership ability, participation in extracurricular activities.
- The scholarship of 300 USD was awarded to Lasangi Dhanapala in 2021.





### Vidya Scholarship Trust Fund (VSTF)

- VSTF was initiated in 2009 and is one of the oldest projects carried out by MGCAANA.
- VSTF is a legal trust registered in Sri Lanka and created by MGCAANA. It provides financial aid to economically disadvantaged students at Mahamaya Girls' College.
- In 2018, we reached our initial goal of 20,000 USD. Last year, the goal was increased to 30,000 USD.



# Nanda Pussegoda Leula Memorial Scholorship (NPLMS)

- This project provides financial aid to economically disadvantaged students at Mahamaya Girls' College as well as to a student-run organization at Mahamaya to perform a community service project, using a personal donation given by Mrs. Leula's daughter Kanthi Leula in memory of her mother, who was a valued alumna of MGCAANA.
- We received a donation of 1100 USD in 2020/2021

 A donation of \$100.00 each was made to Project Sweet Peas (USA) and Cancer Care Manitoba (Canada).
